**GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS:**

Minnesota Statutes 122A.18 gives authorization to issue a lifetime Qualified short-call substitute teaching license. (See the attached requirements and application submission checklist.) Complete Section 2 and forward this page to your Teacher Retirement Association to complete Section 3. Out-of-state applicants must also submit official transcripts and a photocopy of their most recent teaching license.

**!!! Senior citizen enrollment and fees @ MN State Colleges & Universities:**

As provided in [Minnesota Statute 135A.51](#) and [Minnesota Statute 135A.52](#), senior citizens 62 years of age or older who are **residents** of **Minnesota** can pay an administrative fee per semester credit to be enrolled in credit courses on a space-available basis after all students who pay regular fees have been accommodated. Senior citizens are responsible for course materials, textbooks and special course fees.

There is no limit to the number of terms, quarters or semesters a senior citizen may attend courses, nor income limitation imposed in determining eligibility.

There are no administrative fee charges to a senior citizen **auditing** a course.
